**DDOT Traffic Advisory: Right Lane Closure on I-295 Southbound between Exit 2 - South Capitol St./Malcolm X Ave./JBAB and Exit 1 -US Naval Research Lab/Blue Plains  
October 4-11, 2021**

(Washington, D.C.) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will close the southbound right lane on I-295 between Exits 1 and 2 for milling and final paving/stripping operations.

The roadwork will start Monday, October 4, 2021 and continue through Monday, October 11, 2021 from 7AM-2PM daily, weather permitting. Periodic brief closures of Exit 1 - US Naval Research Lab/Blue Plains may occur during this time so the public is advised to use Exit 2 - South Capitol St./Malcolm X Ave./JBAB as an alternate.

Periodic lane closures will be required for equipment mobilization, utility upgrades, and pavement work, including guardrail installations associated with this location as part of multiple DDOT improvement projects along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
