Intermittent Full Closures on New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge November 11, 2021

(Washington, DC) - The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will implement intermittent full closures for both directions of South Capitol Street on the Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge throughout the day on Thursday, November 11. These closures are necessary for construction activities associated with the South Capitol Street Corridor Project which includes construction of the New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge and the reconstruction of the I-295/ Suitland Parkway interchange.

Please observe the posted speed limit and proceed through the construction area with caution. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to stay alert and follow signage when traveling through this area.
