

## **DDOT Traffic Advisory: Temporary Closures on I-295 Northbound and Southbound February 10 – February 15, 2020**

(Washington, DC) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close single lanes and shoulders on the following roadways to perform construction activities along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.

The following closures will be in place daily from Monday, February 10 until Sunday, February 15, 2020 weather permitting:

I-295 Northbound: Laboratory Road / US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway / JBAB (Exit 3A)

- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00 PM – 4:45 AM during February 10 – February 14
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 3:30pm during February 10 – February 14
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am on February 15 to 12:00pm on February 15
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am on February 15 to 12:00pm on February 15
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 4:00am during February 10 – February 14

I-295 Southbound: Laboratory Road / US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway / JBAB (Exit 3A)

- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:45pm - 5:00am during February 10 – February 14
- Single left or right lane closure from Malcolm X Ave. to Laboratory Road/US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) from 7:00am - 12:00pm during February 10 – February 15

Additional Work:

- Right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB and SB from Exit 2(SB) to MLK Jr. Ave. from 9:00am - 3:00pm during February 10 – February 14
- Right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB and SB from Exit 2(SB) to MLK Jr. Ave. from 9:00am on February 15 to 12:00pm on February 15

- Full ramp closure on Ramp E from MLK Jr. Ave. to I-295 NB from 9:00am – 5:00pm during February 10 – February 14
- Full ramp closure on Ramp E from MLK Jr. Ave. to I-295 NB from 9:00am on February 15 to 12pm on February 15
- Single left or right lane closure on South Capitol St. SW & SE, from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 9:00am – 3:00pm during February 10 – February 14
- Single left or right lane closure on South Capitol St. SW & SE, from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 9:00am on February 15 to 12:00pm on February 15
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcolm X Ave. WB from 2<sup>nd</sup> St. to South Capitol Street from 8:30am – 4:30pm during February 10 – February 14
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcolm X Ave. WB from 2<sup>nd</sup> St. to South Capitol Street from 8:30am on February 15 to 12:00pm on February 15
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcolm X Ave. EB South Capitol to/from 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from 8:30am – 4:30pm during February 10 – February 14
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcolm X Ave. EB South Capitol to/from 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from 8:30am on February 15 to 12:00pm on February 15
- Full road closure on South Capitol Street, SE from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 10:00pm – 5:00am during February 10 – February 14
- Full road closure on South Capitol Street, SE from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 10:00am on February 14 to 12:00pm on February 14

These closures are required for pavement work, guardrail installation and equipment mobilization associated with multiple DDOT projects aimed at improving the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
