Temporary Closures of Suitland Parkway, SE

September 21 – September 26, 2020

September 28 – October 03, 2020

Weeknights 8:00 PM to 5:00 AM

Saturday 5:00 AM to 9:00 PM

(Washington, D.C.) The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close Suitland Parkway, SE between South Capitol Street, SE/SW and Firth Sterling Avenue, SE on weeknights from **Monday, September 21 through Friday September 25, 2020** and **Monday, September 28 through Friday October 2, 2020**, from 8:00 pm to 5:00 am the following morning.

For both weeks, this closure will also continue **Saturday, September 26, 2020** and **Saturday, October 3, 2020**, from 5:00 am to 9:00 pm. In the event of inclement weather or other unforeseen delays, the Saturday closures will occur on **Sunday, September 27, 2020** and **Sunday, October 4, 2020** as alternate days. A marked detour will be in place during these closures

This closure is associated with the bridge reconstruction shown in the highlighted area in the below graphic.

These closures are necessary for construction activities associated with the South Capitol Street Corridor Project, which includes construction of the New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge and the reconstruction of the I-295/ Suitland Parkway interchange.
