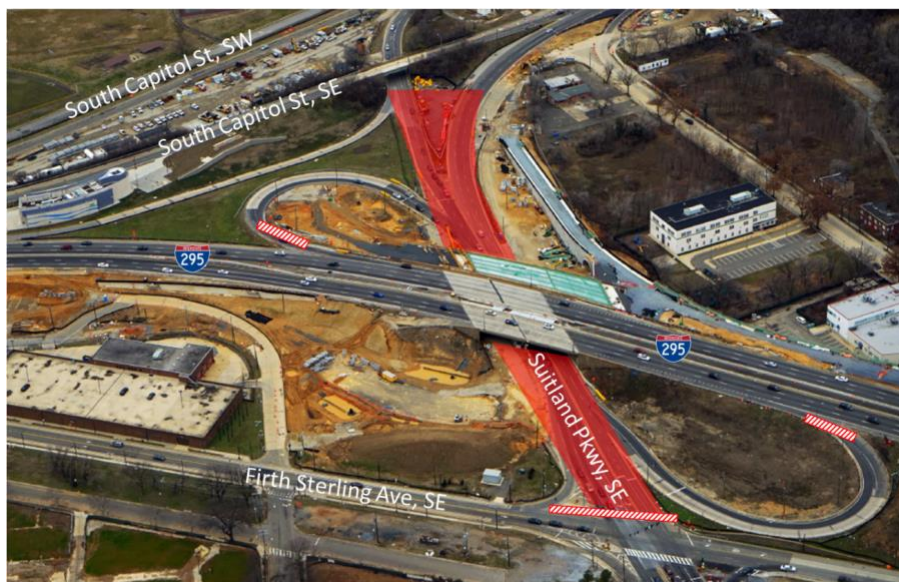

Suitland Parkway, SE Temporary Closure May 16 & May 30, 2020

(Washington, D.C.) The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close Suitland Parkway, SE between South Capitol Street, SE/SW and Firth Sterling Avenue, SE from 5:00 am to 7:00 pm, on Saturday, May 16, 2020 and Saturday May 30, 2020 for bridge reconstruction, as shown in the below graphic. In the event of weather or other unforeseen delays the closure will occur the Sunday following the scheduled closure. A marked detour will be in place during these closures.



Suitland Parkway, SE Closure

These closures are necessary for construction activities associated with the South Capitol Street Corridor Project which includes construction of the New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge and the reconstruction of the I-295/ Suitland Parkway interchange.
