DDOT Traffic Advisory: Right Lane Closure on DC-295 Southbound and Northbound between Nannie H. Burroughs Ave. & Eastern Ave., July 19-24, 2021

(Washington, D.C.) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) plans to demolish the remaining Lane Place pedestrian bridge abutments and will close the right lanes of DC-295 in each direction between Nannie Helen Burroughs Ave., NE and Eastern Ave., NE.

The roadwork will begin Monday, July 19, 2021 and continue through Friday, July 23, 2021 from 7AM-2PM in the northbound lanes and from 10AM-5PM in the southbound lanes, weather permitting. If necessary, work may extend to Saturday, July 24, 2021 from 7AM-5PM.
