

DDOT Traffic Advisory: Temporary Closures on I-295 Northbound and Southbound May 26 – May 31, 2020

(Washington, DC) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close single lanes and shoulders on the following roadways to perform construction activities along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.

The following closures will be in place daily from Tuesday, May 26 until Sunday, May 31, 2020 weather permitting:

I-295 Northbound: Laboratory Road / US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway / JBAB (Exit 3A)

- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 6:00pm 5:00am during May 26
 May 30
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00am 4:00pm during May 27 May 30
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 12:00pm 4:00pm during May 26
 May 26
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00am 2:00pm during May 30
 May 31
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00am 4:00am during May 27
 May 30
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 12:00pm 4:00am during May 26 May 26

I-295 Southbound: Laboratory Road / US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway / JBAB (Exit 3A)

- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 8:00pm 5:00am during May 26
 May 30
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00am 4:00pm during May 27 May 30
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 12:00pm 4:00pm during May 26
 May 26
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00am 2:00pm during May 30
 May 31
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 7:00am to 4:00pm during May 27
 May 30
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 12:00pm to 4:00pm during May 26 – May 26

- Single right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB and SB from Exit 2(SB) to MLK Jr.
 Ave. from 6:00am 4:00pm during May 27 May 30
- Single right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB and SB from Exit 2(SB) to MLK Jr.
 Ave. from 12:00pm 4:00pm during May 26 May 26
- Single left or right lane closure on South Capitol St. SW & SE, from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 6:00am – 3:00pm during May 27 – May 30
- Single left or right lane closure on South Capitol St. SW & SE, from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 12:00pm 3:00pm during May 26 May 26
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcolm X Ave. WB from 2nd St. to South Capitol Street from 6:00am – 4:30pm during May 27 – May 30
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcolm X Ave. WB from 2nd St. to South Capitol Street from 12:00pm – 4:30pm during May 26 – May 26
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcom X Ave. EB South Capitol to/from 2nd Street from 7:00am – 4:30pm during May 27 – May 30
- Single left or right lane closure on Malcom X Ave. EB South Capitol to/from 2nd Street from 12:00pm – 4:30pm during May 26 – May 26
- Road closure on South Capitol Street, SE from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 7:00am – 5:00am during May 27 – May 30
- Road closure on South Capitol Street, SE from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 12:00pm – 5:00am during May 26 – May 26
- Single right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB from MLK Jr. Ave. to Exit 2(SB) from 6:00am 4:00pm during May 27 May 30

- Single right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB from MLK Jr. Ave. to Exit 2(SB) from 12:00pm – 4:00pm during May 26 – May 26
- Single right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB from MLK Jr. Ave. to South Capitol Street Bridge from 6:00am to 6:00am during May 27 May 30
- Single right lane closure on South Capitol St. SE NB from MLK Jr. Ave. to South Capitol Street Bridge from 12:00pm to 6:00am during May 26 May 26
- Full ramp closure on Ramp E from MLK Jr. Ave. to I-295 NB from 6:00am to 6:00am during May 18 – May 31

These closures are required for pavement work, guardrail installation and equipment mobilization associated with multiple DDOT projects aimed at improving the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
