DDOT Traffic Advisory: Right Lane Closure on I-295 Northbound at Nannie Helen Burroughs Ave. NE, March 15 - March 19, 2021

(Washington, D.C.) — The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will close the Northbound right lane on I-295 at Nannie Helen Burroughs Ave. NE for roadwork.

The following roadwork will begin Monday, March 15 through Friday March 19 weather permitting 7am-7pm.

Periodic lane closures will be required for equipment mobilization, utility upgrades, and pavement work, including guardrail installations associated with this location as part of multiple DDOT improvement projects along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
