






Infrastructure Improvements I-295/295 DC

The New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge


Overview

Replacement of 68-year old bridge and reconstruction of Suitland Parkway I-295 interchange

Project Elements

- Six Lane Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge
- Bicycle and pedestrian facilities
- Drainage and stormwater management throughout the corridor

Construction Cost: \$441M

Overview

Reconstruction of the I-295 interchange with Malcolm X Avenue SE, including modified ramps and a new access roadway to the St. Elizabeth's West Campus.

Rehabilitation of the Anacostia Bridges at Nicholson Street, SE

Overview

 Eliminate and address the structural deficiencies and increase safety

Project Elements

- Rehabilitated bridges
- > Improved drainage and roadway
- > Upgraded pedestrian (LED) lighting
- New pedestrian walkway on southside of Nicholson Street

Construction Cost: \$11 M

IMPROVING 295 DC

Overview

The project objective is to rehabilitate the two bridges to eliminate all deficiencies, increase safety for the traveling public and enhance the durability of the bridge structures

Project Elements


- Rehabilitate two bridges to eliminate all deficiencies
- New barrier walls
- Improved lighting
- New traffic signage

Construction Cost: \$8M

- Lane realignment






