Temporary Lane Closure: NB South Capitol Street, SE at Firth Sterling Ave., SE

On/About November 19, 2020

(Washington, D.C.) - The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will close northbound South Capitol Street, SE at Firth Sterling Avenue, SE on/about Thursday, November 19, 2020, as shown in the following graphic. Signage will be provided to detour northbound South Capitol Street traffic into the right lane prior to Firth Sterling Avenue, SE. All traffic will then turn right onto Firth Sterling Avenue, SE, then left onto Suitland Parkway, SE and back to northbound South Capitol Street, SE.

The detour route will be posted with signs advising drivers of the route. All travelers are advised to stay alert and obey the posted speed limit throughout the work area and detour route.

This closure is a result of the reconstruction of the I-295/ Suitland Parkway interchange associated with the South Capitol Street Corridor Project, which includes construction of the New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge.
