

## **DDOT Traffic Advisory: Temporary Closures on I-295 Northbound and Southbound December 30 – January 5, 2020**

(Washington, DC) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close single lanes and shoulders on the following roadways to perform construction activities along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.

The following closures will be in place daily from Monday, December 30 until Sunday, January 5, 2020 weather permitting:

### **I-295 Northbound: Laboratory Road / US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway / JBAB (Exit 3A)**

- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00 PM – 4:45 AM during December 30 – December 30.
- Single left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 9:00 PM – 4:45 AM during January 2 – January 2.
- Left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 4:00am during December 30 – December 30.
- Left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 12:00pm during December 31– December 31.
- Left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 12:00pm – 4:00am during January 2- January 2.
- Left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 4:00am during January 3- January 4.
- Single left or right lane closure from Laboratory Road/US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway/JBAB (Exit 3A) from 4:45 am – 4:45 am during January 4-Janury 5.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 3:30pm during December 30 – December 30.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 12:00pm during December 31 – December 31.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 12:00pm – 3:30pm during January 2- January 2.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 3:30pm during January 3 – January 4.

**I-295 Southbound: Laboratory Road / US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway / JBAB (Exit 3A)**

- Left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:45pm - 5:00am during December 30 – December 30.
- Left or right lane closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:45pm - 5:00am during January 2- January 4.
- Left or right lane closure from Malcolm X Ave. to Laboratory Road/US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) from 7:00am - 12:00pm during December 30 – December 31.
- Left or right lane closure from Malcolm X Ave. to Laboratory Road/US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) from 7:00am - 12:00pm during January 3-January 4.
- Single left or right lane closure from Laboratory Road/US Navel Research Lab (Exit 1) to Suitland Parkway/JBAB (Exit 3A) from 4:45 am – 4:45 am during January 4-January 5.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 3:30pm during December 30 – December 30.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am – 12:00pm during December 31– December 31.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 12:00 – 3:30pm during January 2 – January 2.
- Left or right shoulder closure between Exits 1-3 from 10:00am –3:30pm during January 3-January 4.

  - Left or right lane closure on Malcom X Ave. EB South Capitol to/from 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from 8:30am – 12:00pm during December 31 – December 31.
  - Left or right lane closure on Malcom X Ave. EB South Capitol to/from 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from 12:00am – 4:30pm during January 2 – January 2.
  - Left or right lane closure on Malcom X Ave. EB South Capitol to/from 2<sup>nd</sup> Street from 8:30am – 4:30pm during January 3 – January 4.

- Full road closure on South Capitol Street, SE from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 10:00pm – 5:00am during December 30 – December 30.
- Full road closure on South Capitol Street, SE from MLK Jr. Ave. to Malcolm X Ave. from 10:00pm – 5:00am during January 2 – January 4.

These closures are required for pavement work, guardrail installation and equipment mobilization associated with multiple DDOT projects aimed at improving the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
