**DDOT Traffic Advisory: Temporary Closure on I-295
Southbound November 13 – November 14, 2020**

(Washington, DC) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close single lanes and shoulders on the following roadways to perform construction activities along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.

The following closures will be in place daily from Friday, November 13 until Saturday, November 14, 2020 weather permitting:

- Full road closure on I-295 southbound from Laboratory Road / US Naval Research Lab (Exit 1) to Malcolm X Ave/St. Capitol Street/JBAB (Exit 2) starting at 8:00pm to 8:00am (**continuous**) from November 13th to November 14th

These closures are required for pavement work, guardrail installation and equipment mobilization associated with multiple DDOT projects aimed at improving the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
