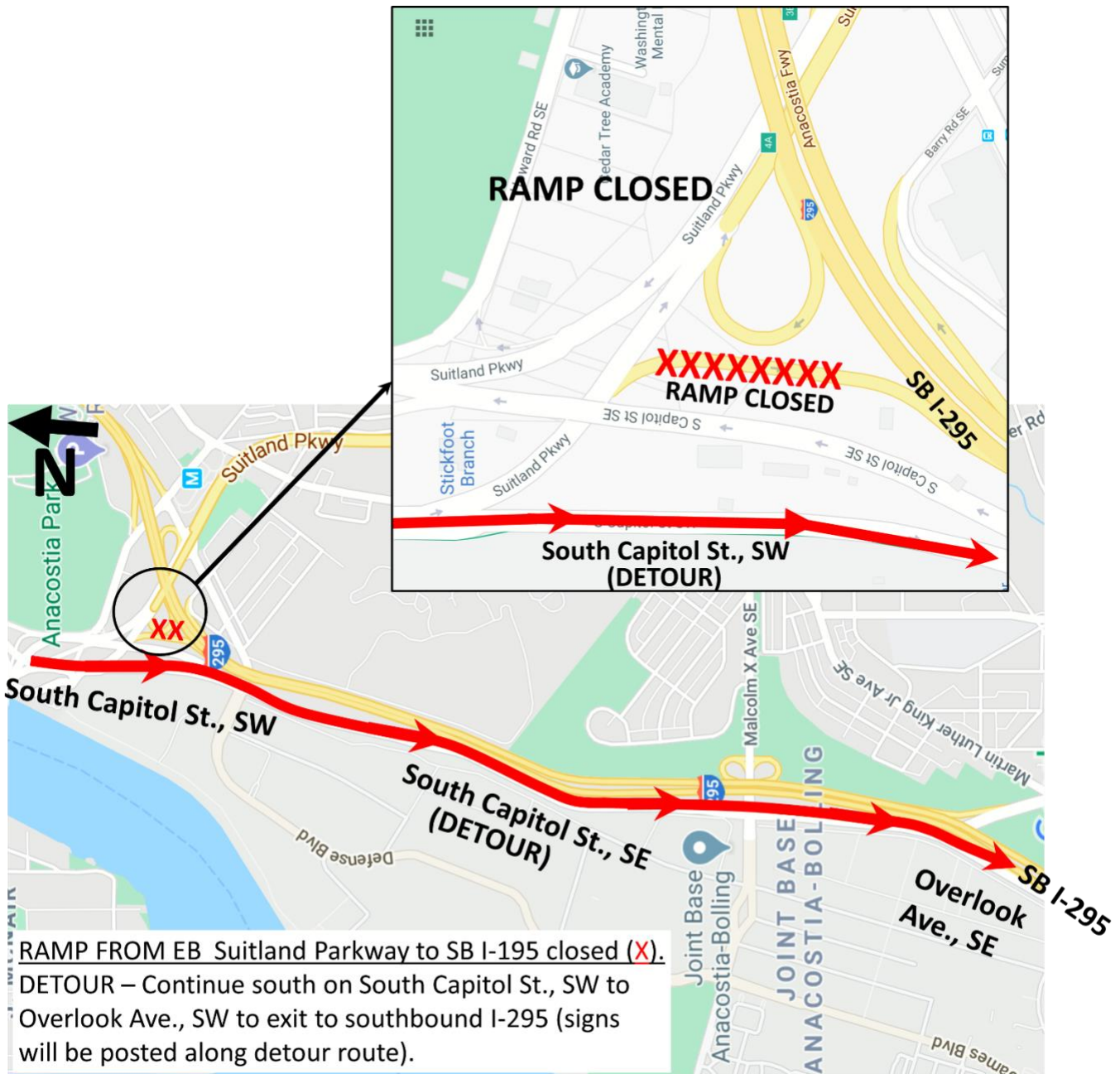
Permanent Closure of RAMP from EB Suitland Parkway to SB I-295

July 30, 2020

(Washington, D.C.) The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will permanently close **the RAMP from EB Suitland Parkway to SB I-295** from July 30, 2020 as shown in the below graphic. Traffic will be detoured to southbound South Capitol Street, SW to Overlook Avenue, SW to SB I-295.

This closure is a result of the reconstruction of the I-295/ Suitland Parkway interchange associated with the South Capitol Street Corridor Project, which includes construction of the New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge.

Pedestrian and cyclist access to Anacostia Metrorail Station remains unchanged. However, pedestrians and cyclists are advised to stay alert and follow signage when traveling through this area as well as the surrounding construction areas.
