DDOT Traffic Advisory: Work to begin on Chesapeake Street, SW On-Ramp to Northbound I-295, March 29 – August 13, 2021

(Washington, D.C.) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will begin work at the Chesapeake Street, SW on-ramp to I-295 Northbound. Travel will be maintained in the existing lane for approximately one week then shift left to an adjacent temporary pavement lane during construction of the new ramp.

The roadwork will begin Monday, March 29 through Friday, August 13, weather permitting, 7am-5pm.

Periodic lane closures will be required for equipment mobilization, utility upgrades, and pavement work, including guardrail installations associated with this location as part of multiple DDOT improvement projects along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
