DDOT Traffic Advisory: Right Lane Closure on DC-295 Southbound between Nannie H. Burroughs Ave. & Eastern Ave., July 28 - August 4, 2021

(Washington, D.C.) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) continues to demolish the Lane Place pedestrian bridge abutments and will close the right lane of southbound DC-295 between Nannie Helen Burroughs Ave., NE and Eastern Ave., NE.

The roadwork will begin Wednesday, July 28, 2021 and continue through Wednesday, August 4, 2021, excluding the weekend, from 10AM-5PM.
