DDOT Traffic Advisory: Alternating Lane Closure on I-295 Northbound at Chesapeake Street, SW, March 29, 2021

(Washington, D.C.) —The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will continue reducing travel to one lane on northbound I-295 at Chesapeake Street, SW for roadwork. Travel in a single lane will alternate between the left and right lane through the workzone.

The roadwork will occur on Monday, March 29 weather permitting 10am-5pm.

Periodic lane closures will be required for equipment mobilization, utility upgrades, and pavement work, including guardrail installations associated with this location as part of multiple DDOT improvement projects along the I-295/DC 295 corridor.
