

Temporary Lane Closures on Suitland Parkway Weeknights & Weekend July 26 through August 2, 2021

(Washington, D.C.) - The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close Eastbound Suitland Parkway east of South Capitol Street SW weeknights from 9:00 p.m. July 26, 2021, to 5:00 a.m. July 30 as shown in the graphic. In addition, Eastbound Suitland Parkway will be closed from 9:00 p.m. July 30 through 5:00 a.m. August 2. When Eastbound Suitland Parkway is fully closed, Firth Sterling Avenue SE and South Capitol Street SE will remain open to all traffic. A marked detour will be in place during this closure.

A marked detour will be in place during these closures. Please observe the posted speed limit and proceed through the construction area with caution. Pedestrians and cyclists are advised to stay alert and follow signage when traveling through this area. These closures are necessary for construction activities associated with the South Capitol Street Corridor Project, which includes construction of the New Frederick Douglass Memorial Bridge and the reconstruction of the I-295/ Suitland Parkway interchange.
